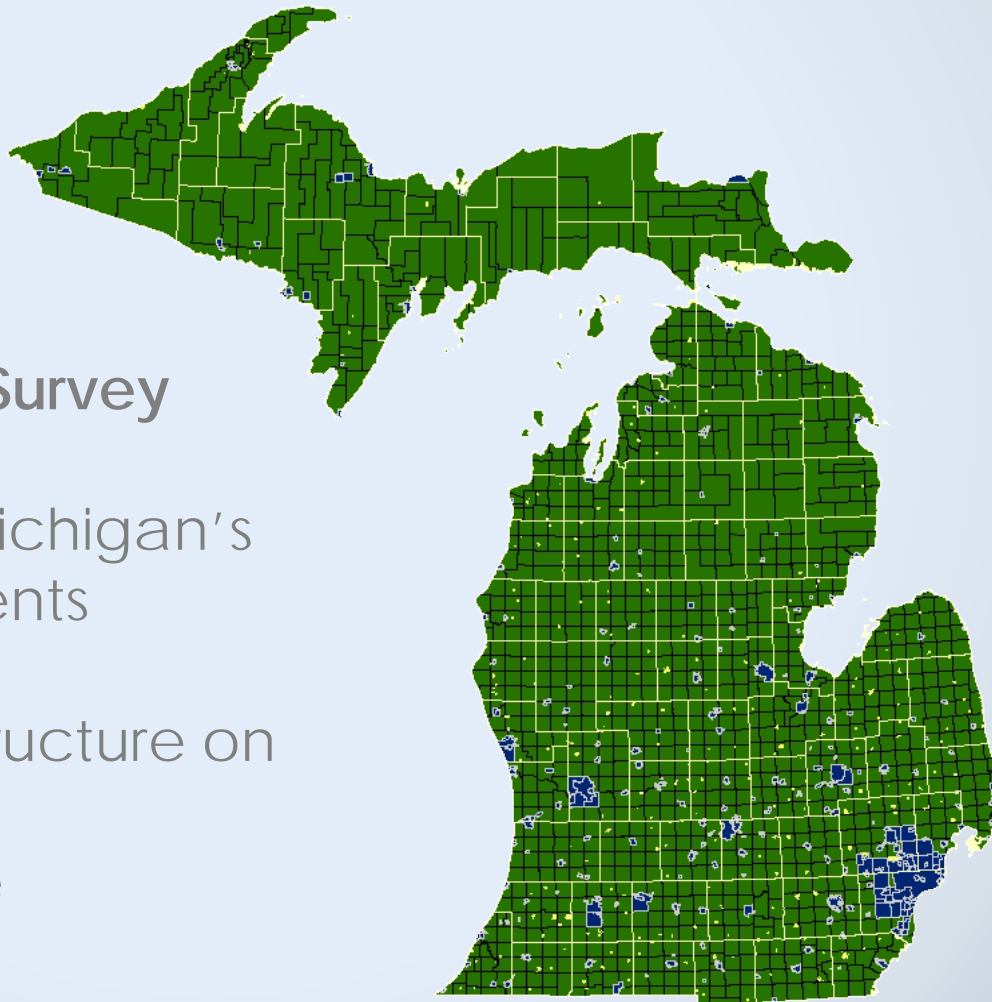


Local government views on drinking water infrastructure

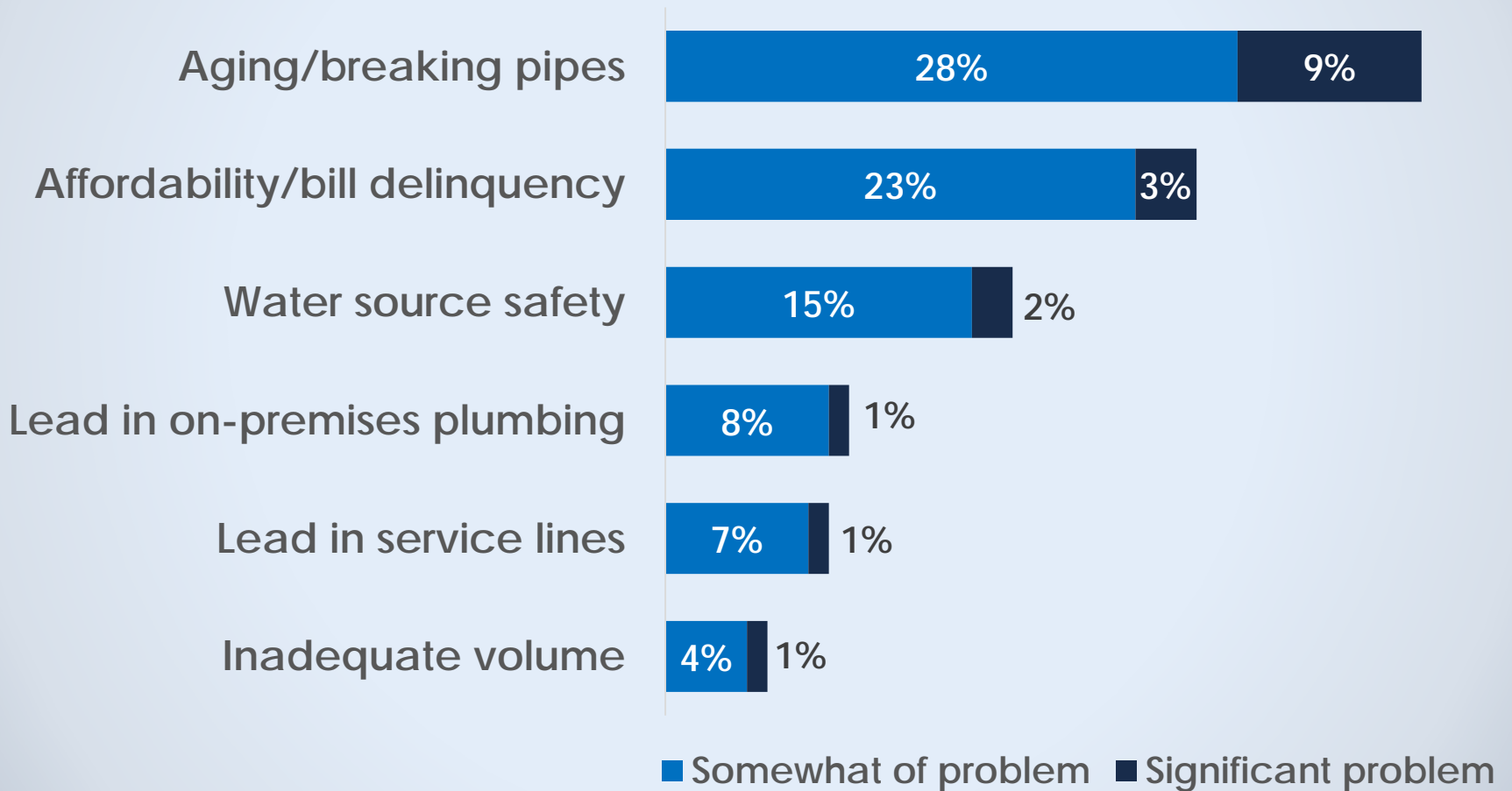
Michigan Public Policy Survey

- Drinking water infrastructure on Spring 2016 wave
 - 74% response rate

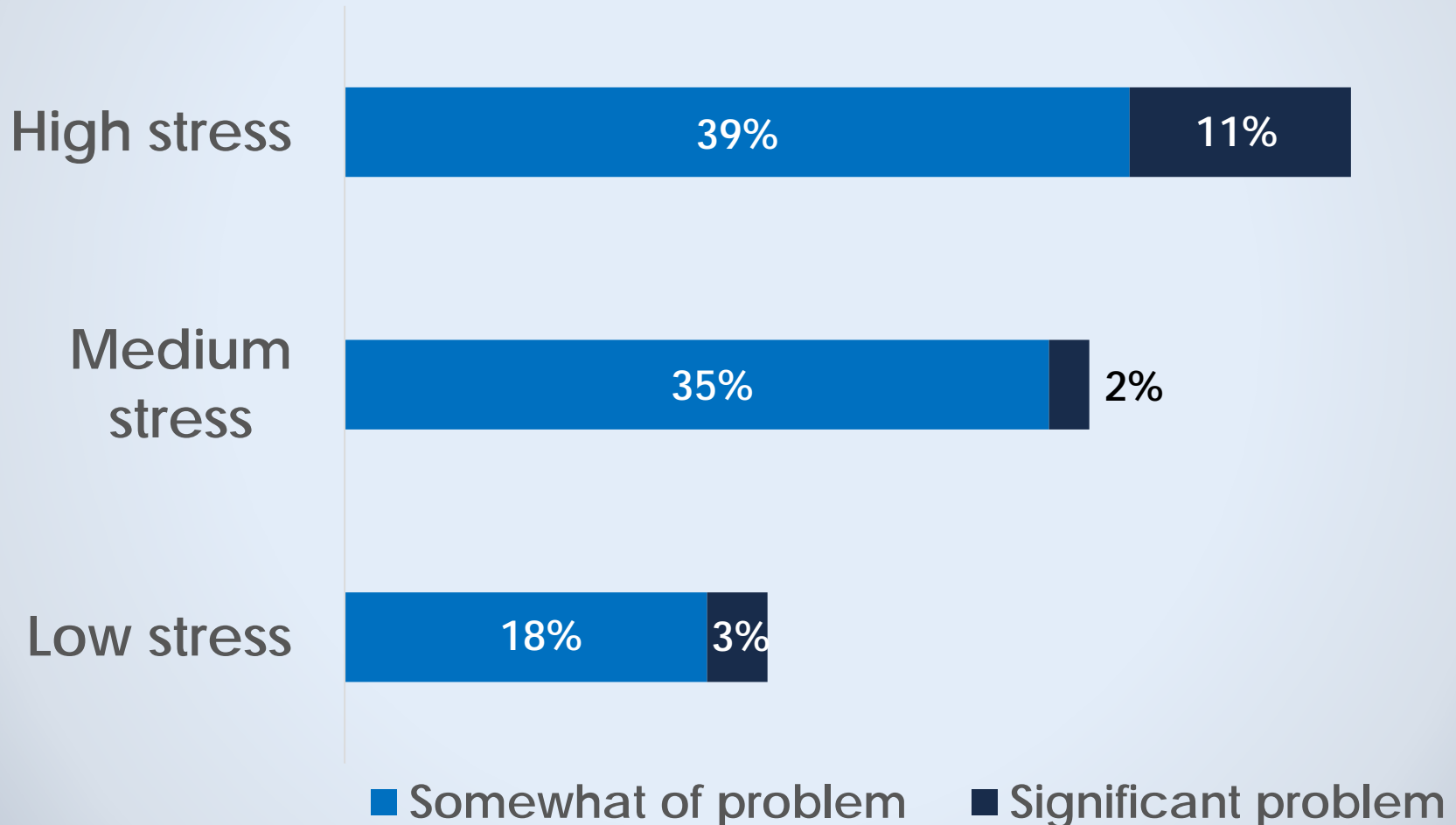


Extent of problems

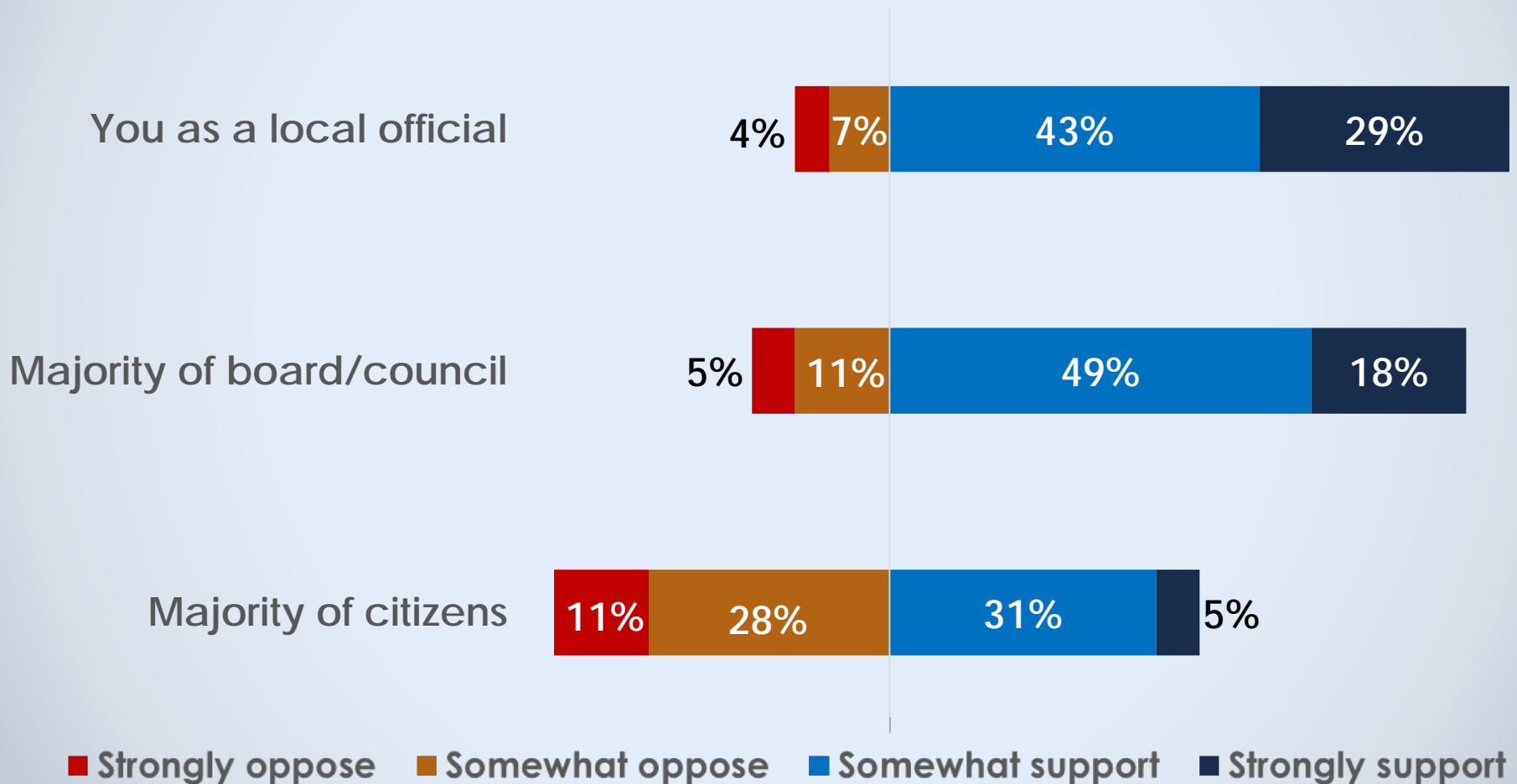
(in jurisdictions with shared systems)

Support for increasing water rates



Much more data available

- Knowledge (or not) of water source
- Change in infrastructure conditions
- Funding sources & needs
- Governmental oversight for water
- Breakdowns by region, population size, county, water system (size-dependent)
